Bed & Breakfast Inns

Belleview Biltmore Resort & Spa

Built in 1897, the Biltmore rests on a high coastal bluff overlooking the Gulf of Mexico. Today, the 292-room resort holds a position on the National Register of Historic Places and hosts more than 140 weddings a year. With unique indoor-banquet facilities, including the classical, 13,000-square-foot Tiffany Ballroom, as well as beautiful grounds, the highly trained event professionals with assist with every detail. It also features a Donald Ross golf course, a newly renovated 14,000-sq.-ft. spa, tennis facilities, boat dock and a 2 ½-mile off-site, semi-private beach.

Don CeSar Beach Resort & Spa

Located on the Gulf of Mexico, The Don CeSar is as rich in luxury as it is in history. Originally opened in 1928, this "pink palace" features Mediterranean and Moorish architecture and includes numerous balconies and terraces. Original owner Thomas Rowe named the 340-room property after a character in the Italian opera *Maritana*. The Don was a favorite of high society including F. Scott Fitzgerald and his wife, Zelda as well as Al Capone and baseball-player Lou Gehrig. A member of the Historic Hotels of North America and the National Register of Historic Places, the Don was also named a historical monument by the National Archives.

The Don CeSar hosts more than 300 weddings per year and their event professionals can assist in everything from an intimate gathering on the beach to 1,000 guests classically attired for a traditional ceremony. The resort's powdery beaches, sweeping staircases and tropical gardens are breathtaking accents for wedding ceremonies and portraits. A comprehensive program at the Don allows brides to arrange either a select few or all wedding details through the resort, from videographers and bands to flowers and cakes. In addition to its white-sand beach, the Don also

includes a Beach Club & Spa featuring sea salt body scrubs and surfside massages to relax any pre-wedding stress.

Renaissance Vinov Resort & Golf Club

Built in 1925, the Renaissance Vinoy Resort is a 375-room property listed in the National Register of Historic Places and is a member of the Historic Hotels of America. In its heyday, the Mediterranean Revival-style hotel was frequented by Calvin Coolidge, Babe Ruth, Herbert Hoover and numerous celebrities and entertainers. The Vinoy has undergone a \$93 million restoration and expansion adding a tower and recreational facilities including an 18-hole, Ron Garl golf course, 74-slip marina and Mediterranean spa.

The historic Vinoy Resort has an expert staff of event managers that can handle all of the wedding details. Several options for the wedding's location include:

- The Tea Garden, providing a tranquil outdoor setting for an intimate gathering
- Vinoy Grand Ballroom, which holds more than 450 and is designed in a 1920s
 Mediterranean décor
- The Esplanade offers an outdoor private area with superb views of the bay and marina
- Sunset Ballroom, which is similar in style to the Grand Ballroom but geared more toward intimate gatherings.

Located on St. Pete Beach, the Sirata Beach Resort & Conference Center provides options for traditional and unique wedding services. Locations

Andrews Memorial Chapel

Located in Hammock Park and constructed in 1888, the chapel is considered a prime example of Victorian architecture in Florida and is listed in the National Register of Historic Places. The unique setting is a popular wedding location and the chapel hosts more than 150 weddings a year. The chapel is constructed with two foyers with Gothic archways leading into the sanctuary where the original stained glass windows still remain.

Egmont Key

Located at the mouth of Tampa Bay south of St. Petersburg, Egmont Key is an undeveloped tropical barrier island accessible only by private charter or aboard excursion vessels. This historic 360-acre island has unique natural and cultural histories including a lighthouse (built in 1858) that is still in operation. The lighthouse continues to operate as Florida's sixth brightest lighthouse. The prime spot for wedding ceremonies is at the base of the lighthouse.

Harborview Center

The Harborview Center can host an event for 40 to 1,400 people, and can provide all the amenities for the occasion. The 35,000-sq.-ft. conference level includes a 17,000-sq.-ft. ballroom, divisible in halves or quarters that can hold 300 to 450 guests each. The 3,900-sq.-ft. Clearwater Room, with its inviting view of the harbor and beachfront skyline, is an impressive site for a reception or luncheon. Wedding Packages include room rental, dance floor, white linens and napkins, skirted DJ Table, head table for 16, gift table and a cake cutting service. The Harborview Center offers several menu options ranging from large buffet to a simple luncheon.

Mirror Lake Lyceum

Located on the west bank of Mirror Lake in historically-rich downtown St. Petersburg, the former First Christian Church, built in 1926, re-opened in early 2000 as a meeting and special events venue. The three-story structure offers a subtle yet unique elegance from the first-floor entrance foyer and main lobby to the ballroom area. The main floor features the 3,478-sq.-ft. grand hall and 2,720-sq.-ft. ballroom and boasts a capacity of 25 to 800. The 1920s stained glass windows have been entirely restored, and the original hardwood floors and inlaid terrazzo enhance the delicate detail of the hand-carved ornamental plaster moldings. Chandeliers and fixtures made of plaster, crystal and alabaster decorate the grand hall with its 53-foot domed ceiling. Wedding parties can also makes use of the Bridal and Groom suites or for the grandest traditional weddings, a Horse Carriage Service.

Sunken Gardens

An exotic collection of more than 50,000 tropical plants and flowers including more than 200 species bloom year-round at this six-acre garden which includes a wedding lawn and a butterfly garden. Owned by the City of St. Petersburg, the Gardens are managed by the Parks Department. The Oak Pavilion and the Butterfly Garden may be used for more intimate gatherings. The gardens are available 7 days a week from 9 a.m. to dusk.

The Florida Botanical Gardens at Pinewood Cultural Park

The Florida Botanical Gardens is one of the newest attractions in the area and hosts a Celebration Garden in addition to seven other unique gardens. The Celebration Garden is ideal for outdoor weddings with its formal floral designs, an open grass plaza and a gazebo surrounded by fountains. The Celebration Garden is enclosed with an ivy-covered stone wall to provide privacy for special occasions.

Wedding Butterfly Release by Monarch Butterfly

In addition to a wide variety of facilities and locations for weddings, St. Petersburg is also home to a unique business that caters to wedding events. The Monarch Butterfly Farm provides Monarch Butterflies as well as a variety of other butterfly species to be released at weddings by guests and the wedding party. They have provided butterflies for hundreds of weddings throughout the United States (Note: The Monarch Butterfly Farm does not distribute to states west of the 100th Meridian (Rocky Mountains). The Farm can provide anywhere from 15 to 200 butterflies and provides a keepsake envelope for the butterfly to be released from for a small additional fee.

Marriage License Information

A marriage license may be obtained Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the office of the

Clerk of the Circuit Court.

Both parties of the intended marriage must come into the Clerk's Office. Each party must have

valid photo identification such as a driver's license, state identification card, government or

military identification card, or a passport. A social security number is required to obtain a

marriage license. If either party is from a foreign country and not a U.S. citizen, alien registration

documentation, or other proof that contains an alien registration number is acceptable to obtain a

marriage license. Blood tests are not required to receive a marriage license. The marriage must

be solemnized within 60 days of issuance of the marriage license. The ceremony can be

performed anywhere in the State of Florida.

St. Petersburg/Clearwater – Florida's Beach is the leading destination on Florida's Gulf coast,

drawing more than 12 million visitors annually including 4.7 million overnight visitors who stay

an average of 7 days. The area is best known for 35 miles of spectacular beaches and record-
